During summer months she would load her car with neighborhood kids and go to the AMVET pool. Allegra was very active with her children, helping with both Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts. She never hesitated to give someone a ride to church, the store or doctors appointments. In the early days of computers she helped Pastor Mack and Greater New Hope Baptist set up their very first computer system and taught them how to use it. She started working in 1966 as a book keeper for Detroit Edison and retired in 2004 from Allied Safety Restraint.

For the past 9 years her grandson Frank Ulicny III has been her full time caregiver, companion and best friend. He drove her to Red Hatter luncheons, church, doctor appointments as well as frequent drives along the St. Clair river to enjoy the water, freighters and a ice cream cone.
