Tony was a hard working man, a blue collared boot wearing individual. He was well liked and well respected with a big heart. Tony will be greatly missed.

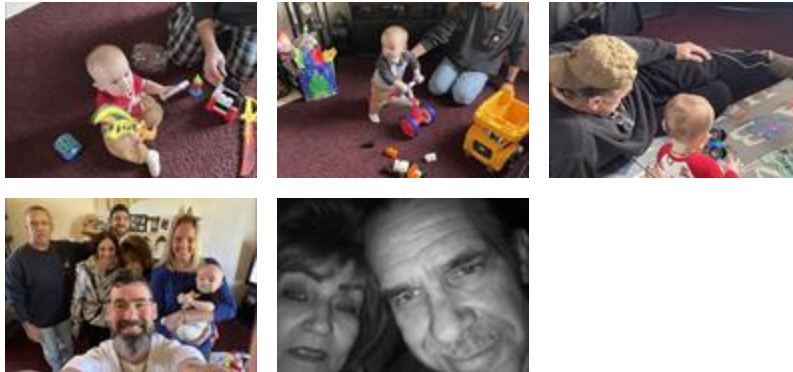
