Arthur "Art" Tyll a 16 year resident of Utica passed away Thursday; November 30, 2006 at Wm. Beaumont Hospital in Troy at the age of 76. He was born July 3, 1930 in Detroit. Mr. Tyll retired from the Detroit Fire Department. He served in the Korean War and was honored with the Purple Heart in 2005, 54 years after his injuries.
