Bradley Carl Staeb passed away suddenly on Sunday April 7, 2019 at the age of 60. Bradley was born on August 24, 1958 in Mt. Clemens to Erwin and Kathryn Staeb. Growing up in the Macomb County area, Brad attended L'Anse Creuse public schools graduating in 1976. Being the kind of guy that wanted to take care of people, Brad entered into the financial services industry and quickly stood out as the sort of financial planner that folks sought out. Worried less about what was right for his commission checks and more for what was right for his clients, gave Brad the edge that kept his clients loyal to him for years. Brad never let his office life take over his home life. He never missed a soccer game, never missed a LaCrosse match, and was always in the stands at cheerleading competitions. No matter what sport he was cheering on he was always the loudest fan in the stands. Through his affiliations with his kids schools, Brad bled purple and gold for the De La Salle Pilots and green and gold for the Notre Dame Prep Fighting Irish.
