September 9, 1948 - December 30, 2015

Carol Angela Stier (nee Cox) was born at St Joseph's on the Boulevard Hospital, Detroit, on September 9th, 1948 to parents, William and Grace. She joined older siblings, Mary, John, and Michael, and later family additions by younger sisters, Catherine, and Trish. Carol attended and graduated from St Mary's of Mount Clemens in 1966. On November 13th, 1963, at a "Bad Luck Friday the 13th Dance", she met the man who would become the love of her life, Jeffrey Paul Stier; together they had many years of travel, most especially to locations where they could ski together. Seriously dating for many years, they became engaged on Christmas Eve 1970, and Married October 1st, 1971 at St Peter's Catholic Church Mount Clemens, honeymooning in Northern MI. Working as a phlebotomist at St John's Harrison, she and her new husband moved into an apartment in Jeffrey's hometown of Waldenburg, MI; eventually welcoming a son, Jeffrey K, December 21, 1975, and a daughter, Amanda, February 20, 1978. To accommodate their growing family, they purchased and moved into the home they would occupy for the next several decades.

As a mother, two of her proudest moments came on the days that both of her children became college graduates; and having always taken enormous pride in her children and their lives, one of Carol's happiest moments was watching her son, Jeff marry his wife, Michele in December 2009. Carol will always be remembered for her enormous (and sometimes biting) sense of humor; her

off-hand comments could often send the unsuspecting listener either into gales of laughter or furious blushing (most especially her daughter-in-law). In addition to her humor, her laughter was known to be explosive and could fill the house, one would be hard pressed not to join in.

Carol went home to her Savior on Wednesday, December 30, 2015, and is predeceased into Paradise by her parents.
