



## Charles Chris Brown

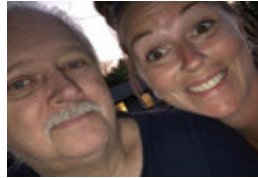
December 3, 1948 - June 8, 2020

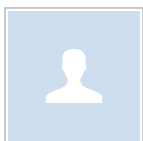
