Or you can cherish his memory and let it live on.*

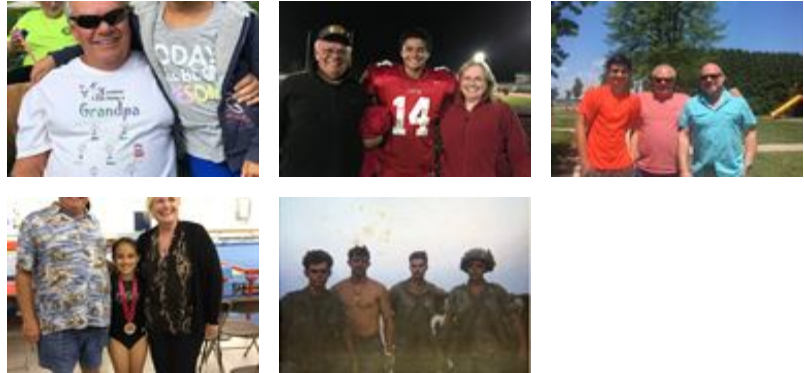
*You can cry and close your mind, be empty, and turn your back
