



## Christine Clementine Alaszewski

January 12, 1932 - April 14, 2025

Christine was born in Poland in 1932. As an orphan, she was liberated from Siberia in 1941. She was sent to the Transitional Refugee Camp in Persia (now Iran). From there, the orphans were sent to Camp Santa Rosa in Mexico. Once Camp Santa Rosa was scheduled to close in 1945, the President of the Polish National Alliance (PNA) in the United States helped arrange sponsors for these orphaned girls. A special act of congress allowed for the refugees to come to the U.S.A. The Felician Nuns, in their Guardian Angels Home in Detroit sponsored 25 of these girls, one of which was Christine.

Christine was taken in by foster parents, Anthony and Mary Florkey. She graduated from the Felician Academy, although it took 10¢, 3 busses, and 2 transfers to get there, and another 3 busses to get to Woolworth's, where she worked as a soda jerk. She later worked at The Polish Daily News.

Throughout her life she was very active in the PNA, where she met her husband of 49 years, Bronislaw.

Christine retired from Seiko Carboloy, where she worked in inside sales. She was admired so much that one of her clients in Seattle flew her and her husband to Seattle for a dinner in her honor.

Christine passed away on April 14, 2025, in the company of her family. She was preceded in death by her husband and grandson, William. She is survived by her son Mark (Theresa), her daughter Lydia (Martin Limbaugh), her daughter Brigette (Allen) Pilarski, grandchildren Claire (Andreas)

Weissmann, Adam (Emily) Pilarski, Monica (Tyler Newman), Jay Alaszewski and great-grandchildren, Marlee and Zennon Weissmann.

A private funeral service for the family will be held Wednesday, April 16, 2025.
