Christopher played a vital part of our little gaming community/discord group Medium Effort over the last several years. In fact, "medium effort" was a term he had used to describe our collective feeling towards gaming - and so we named the group exactly that. Relaxing, joking, laughing a lot, and playing cooperative computer games. In a world full of stressful and competitive environments, this was a place to play at your own pace - and he was a large part of this effort.

Respectful, welcoming, generous, and jovial are just a few words I would use to describe his personality with us. He always took the time to explain things in an effort to teach rather than tell - and that is a difficult skill to acquire as well as maintain. He excelled at this. Quite a role-model.

The main game we would play was World of Warcraft. He very much enjoyed playing a protection paladin - which for those unaware, is a tank class. Being a tank meant you were in charge of planning routes, calculating percentages, knowing the sometimes complicated mechanics of a fight, and being able to lead a 5 person team through these fights. This, likely pointed to his personality. Caring and protective. When a few of us would be playing Call of Duty zombies - he would break into song, singing "Zombies" by the Cranberries, which always got a chuckle.

He spoke very highly of his family, and would talk fondly of the Sunday brunches/meals with them. Occasionally he would connect to a voice channel while making the drive to these brunches. He also told us about the men's chorus he was a part of - and how much he enjoyed it. It was obvious he loves his family.

Although we never met in person, several weeks ago on a random Friday night, we did a group call for a few hours where for the first time in almost 4 years we all saw faces of "voices" we had heard at

least a few times a week since around 2020. Of course Christopher was a part of that call. It was a great experience.

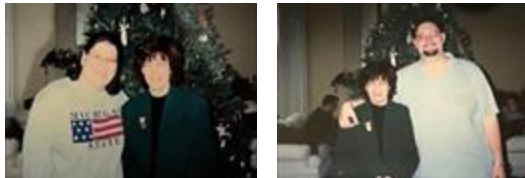
