



Dorothy M. Doherty

January 21, 1930 - February 7, 2023

Dorothy Mae (Kraus) Doherty passed away at the age of 93 on February 7, 2023 in Troy, Michigan.

Dorothy is survived by her three children, Thomas Doherty, Susan George, and Constance (Kevin Miller) Doherty, grandchildren Laura (Jim) Harris, Drew Miller, Christopher (Yvonne) George and Abigail Miller, and siblings James Kraus, Nancy Janik, and Virginia Rambo. She was predeceased by her former husband and cherished friend Thomas Doherty and her sister Jane Rech.

Dorothy earned her teaching degree from Marquette University and was a devoted elementary school teacher for close to thirty years, spending most of those years at St. Clement Grade School in Center Line, Michigan. She leaves behind thousands of former students who remember her gentle nature and love of learning.

Dorothy often said that she would “rather wear out than rust out,” and she lived out that wish. In her retirement, she was a tutor for the Macomb Literacy Partners, a classroom volunteer for Fitzgerald Public Schools, and a Chaplain Aide for St. John Providence Hospital. It brought her great joy to share her faith with hospital patients and to offer them Communion and comfort. She was also an avid reader and a passionate gardener.

Dorothy made many friends at Oakmont Sterling Senior Living, and enjoyed bible study, book club, and other activities with them. Her time there was happy and she truly felt at home.

A memorial mass will be held at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, April 21st at St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church in Warren, Michigan, with a luncheon to celebrate Dorothy's life afterward at the American Polish Century Club, 33204 Maple Lane in Sterling Heights, Michigan. 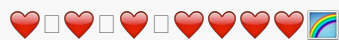
