



Frank Joseph Servitto

January 13, 1940 - November 29, 2017

Frank Joseph Servitto Jr. was born January 13, 1940 in Detroit, MI to Frank & Josephine (Smigielski) Servitto. He grew up on the east side of Detroit and attended St. Elizabeth's grade school and St. Stanislaus High School graduating in 1957.

After high school he enlisted in the Navy and it was his honor to become a Navy Corpsman serving as a medic in the Marines. His service took him all over the Pacific including Japan, Southeast Asia, and Hawaii. While stationed in Hawaii he met (on a blind date) Mary Ellen Moore of Tenafly, NJ and married. After being discharged from the Navy, he and Mary Ellen returned to the mainland and settled on the east side of Detroit where they raised their three children and became very active members at St. Raymond's parish and school.

Frank earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Wayne State University in 1968 and quickly transitioned in to the new field of computing which landed him jobs at Mich. Consolidated Gas Company and eventually at the IRS Data Center in downtown Detroit where he worked for 28 years.

Frank was passionate about his hometown of Detroit, its sports teams, protecting the environment, golfing, estate/garage sales and selling his treasures on eBay. His joyful personality, energy and relentless optimism

made him a rare human being. He will be deeply missed by all fortunate enough to have known him. He died at home surrounded by his family on November 29, 2017 at the age of 77 years old.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Mary Ellen; daughter Colleen (Michael) Eovaldi, grandchildren Joseph and Grace (Spear), Anthony, Sam and MaryKate Eovaldi; son Matt (Anne Lauterbach) Servitto, grandchildren Francesca, Nicholas and Greta Servitto. Predeceased by daughter MaryKate Servitto. Loving sisters Betty Fowler, Carol Brans, Shirley Bates and many nieces and nephews.
