Frank Zrepskey, age 80 of Algonac, Michigan passed away peacefully on July 22, 2023.

Frank B. his elk. Frank was an active member of the Algonac Lions Club, supporting the blind and visually impaired. He was also a member of the North Channel Yacht Club and the St. Clair Flats Waterfowlers.

On Thursday, July 27, 2023, Frank will be lying in state at St. Mary Queen of Creation Church, 50931 Maria St., New Baltimore, starting at 10:00 am, with Mass at 10:30 am. A luncheon will follow at Algonac Lions Club, 1905 Mills St., Algonac.

Though Frank may have departed from our physical presence, his spirit will forever reside within us. May we find comfort in the cherished memories shared and find strength in the love he left behind. Rest in peace, dear Frank. You will be deeply missed and forever remembered.
