September 15, 1914 - September 27, 2011

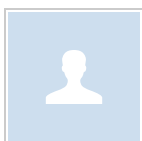

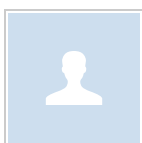
“ Dear Jill & Family,
