George proudly served his country in the United States Navy during the Korean War attaining the rank of Yeoman Petty Officer 3rd Class (YNT3). After serving his country George finished his education and pursued his career in education hiring into the Chippewa Valley School district teaching math at the high school. Along with being a teacher at the high school for 34 years George became the first football coach at Chippewa Valley High School along with coaching the track team, basketball team and the golf team. Following his teaching career George and his wife Adele retired to Florida returning to Michigan just a few months before his death. In his free time George was an avid bowler and loved to golf and fish. George is the beloved husband of Adele. Loving father of George Thayer III, Scott Thayer, and Erik (Krista) Thayer. 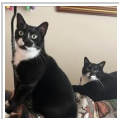
