



Gilbert C. Inman

Gilbert C. Inman, age 89, of Ira Township passed away on March 16, 2022 at Henry Ford Macomb Hospital in Clinton Township. Gilbert, known to most friends and colleagues by his nickname “Dee”, was born and raised in Arkansas. He enlisted in the Air Force in March of 1951 and was stationed at Selfridge Air Force Base. On April 24, 1955 he married Grace Plague, they resided in Algonac and Ira Township.

After active duty Dee joined the Air Force Reserves and serving for 39 years. Dee worked as an aircraft mechanic on jet aircraft, and as a flight engineer on C-119, HC-97, and HC-130 aircraft serving with the 403rd Troop Carrier Wing and 305th Air Rescue Squadron. In 1981 Gilbert became the First Sergeant of the 305th and retired in 1992. During that time Dee was also a civilian Federal employee of the Department of the Army, retiring as an equipment specialist in 1990 from the Army Tank-Automotive Command in Warren, MI
