November 1, 1924 - October 22, 2015

Harold G. Norman Age 90 was called by the Lord on October 22, 2015. Born in Norway, Michigan on November 1, 1924, he was the beloved husband to Mary for 64 years. Harold was the dear father of Darlene (Gary) Patterson, Cheryl (Ron) Gorney and the late Marlene (Mike) Zimmerman. He was the proud and loving grandfather of Stacie, Lindsey, Jeffery, Scott, and Lauren. His great grandchildren included Anna, Avery, Elle and Ana. Harold's brothers are Ken and Herbie Norman. Serving as a corporal in the United States Army Air Force he participated in the Normandy invasion in 1944. At the conclusion of the war, Harold returned home to become a successful automotive wood model builder at Delta and Ring Pattern. He will be remembered as a competitive force in bowling, horseshoes and pool. Carrying a bowling average of 200 he achieved a 300 game and numerous scores exceeding 290. He won a gold medal as a senior Olympian in horseshoes in 2008. Harold was a generous soul who would offer his time and talent to family, neighbors and friends. He will, indeed, be missed by many.
