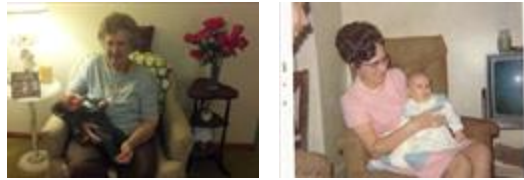
Ecclesiastes 3 A Time for Everything
