This was a strong value and belief that we shared and glued us together as sisters, daughters, aunts and mothers.

Jackie was all of these things and so much more. In all honesty, she was my everything. She was the sunbeam that always managed to break through my rainy days. She had so much positive energy she could lift the world up with it. I want to thank her for keeping me up and running. Jackie was the bringer of good things in my life and the

love we've given each other is the love we've gained.

Whenever Jackie had to babysit it would normally end up with me packing up my red blanket in my little hard shell suitcase and "running away". At this point in time she was just my "big sister" and I wanted her attention. I was just her "little sister" who was interfering with her social life, and we all know how social Jackie was.

Jackie had a knack for getting what she wanted no matter the situation. Like the time she removed my earrings from my ears while I was sleeping because they would go perfect with the outfit she wanted to wear.

When I was 14 Jackie decided I should be a cheerleader like she was. I believe at this time she and Dona Johnson were cheerleading coaches and she was going to coach me, whether I wanted to cheer or not. She talked me into trying out for the Freshman Football Cheerleading Team. She spent hours with me and my best friend Debbie in our backyard teaching us cheers and practicing every cheerleader jump known to humans. She helped us come up with the perfect routines for tryouts and to my horror, I made the team, as did Debbie. Unfortunately Debbie moved away, and I was left to cheer on my own. You see I was a tomboy my whole life. I was an athlete. I played sports. I didn't cheer for those who played sports on the sideline.

It was at age 15 when Jackie realized my sports ability could be useful in her world. Don't get me wrong, Jackie always loved us, but at this point in her life, it was all about "her". So my softball skills as a shortstop were really going to help her Macomb Daily Softball team. My parents filled out the permission slips because I was underage. This began my journey as Jackie's teammate in softball and life. I was shortstop and she was second base and we just meshed. Like Trammel and Whittaker, we made so many double plays because we were so in tune.
