Born September 17, 1927, Philadelphia, PA. In February 1946, due to the Draft, he graduated early from West Catholic High School. He completed his basic training in Battle Creek, Michigan, where he was trained as a military police officer. As a Private First Class, he was stationed at Ft. Wayne in Detroit, Michigan. In total, he served his country for twenty-two months.

After he was discharged from the Army, he returned to Philadelphia, to pursue his undergraduate degree at LaSalle College; continuing on to The Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, graduating in 1956.

He relocated to Michigan to complete his medical residency with the Detroit Osteopathic Hospital Corporation. Upon completion of his residency he joined The Professional Centre Clinic, P.C. in Taylor, Michigan where he practiced for 34 years, delivering over 3,000 new lives into the world, until his retirement in 1993. He was on staff at Riverside Osteopathic Hospital and Southshore (formerly Seaway Hospital). During his career he was a member of the Knights of Columbus.

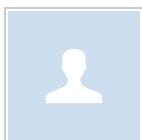

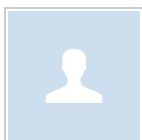
