Jason Mass passed away on April 15, 2023 at the age of 51. Jason was born in Detroit on April 6, 1972 to Stephen and Sue Mass. Jason was a 1990 graduate of De La Salle Collegiate High School and a 1994 graduate of Hillsdale College where he was a three sport athlete. Jason moved to Texas after graduating from Hillsdale and founded Seven - Utility Management Consultants, LLC a successful utility management company. Jason quickly became a leader in the energy sector mentoring his staff on ways to improve contracts for customers as the energy industry was deregulated. In his time in the energy sector Jason earned 3 certificates having to do with the procurement and distribution of energy having attained his certification as a Certified Purchasing Manager (CPM), Certified Energy Procurement Professional (CEP), and a Certified Business Energy Professional (CBEP). Jason stepped aside from his day to day operations of Seven in 2016 selling the company to his trusted employees. Never one to sit still Jason founded Mass Enterprises, LLC and stepped into a role as a consultant for national electricity and natural gas negotiations and management. Jason was also a huge fan of baseball. Having played in high school and college the love of the diamond never left Jason. 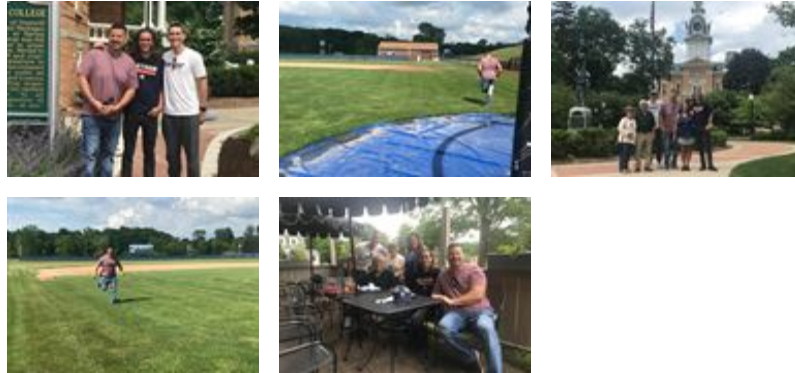
