John proudly served his country in the Air National guard for 11 years serving as a fire protection supervisor from 1955 until 1966 serving at the time of the Berlin Wall and the Cuban Missile Crisis. When Jack left the Air Guard he was honorably discharged attaining the rank of Tech Sergeant (E-6). Jack was a plumber by trade starting to work with his father at the age of 14. Jack's knowledge of this trade went far beyond being a plumber though. He was often tasked with handling large projects where he served as a mechanical contractor. In this role Jack helped in the construction of many schools, hospitals and large industrial buildings. 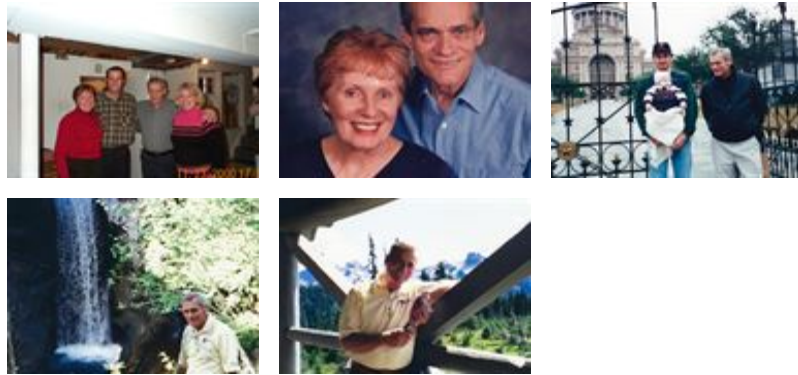
