John Michael Lonczynski was born in Detroit on October 22, 1959 to John Frank and Marion (nee Malczewski) Lonczynski. John passed away after a courageous battle with cancer on Saturday November 7, 2020 at Huntsville Medical Center in Huntsville, Alabama. John was a proud United States Army veteran having served our country in Operation Desert Shield. John retired from the Army as a Staff Sargent having earned the Army Commendation Medal 4th Award, Army Achievement Medal 4th Award, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, Valorous Unit Award, Professional Development ribbon, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Southwest Asia Service Medal with 3 bronze stars. Following his career in the United States Army John used the skills that he acquired in his years in service to his country to pursue a career as a civilian contractor for the United States Army. John was a very proud and active 25 year member of the Masons having served 2 terms as Grand Master. John also contributed his time to organizations like the American Legion as well as to the Wounded Warrior Foundation. John is the beloved father of Michael and David Lonczynski. 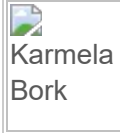
