With heavy hearts, the family of Kathleen Therese Grozenski announces her passing on Sunday, October 24, 2021, at the age of 72 in Keego Harbor, MI. Born August 26, 1949, Kathleen – known as Kathy to family and friends – was adopted at five days old in Detroit, MI. She spent her childhood in the area, ultimately attending St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital Nursing School. 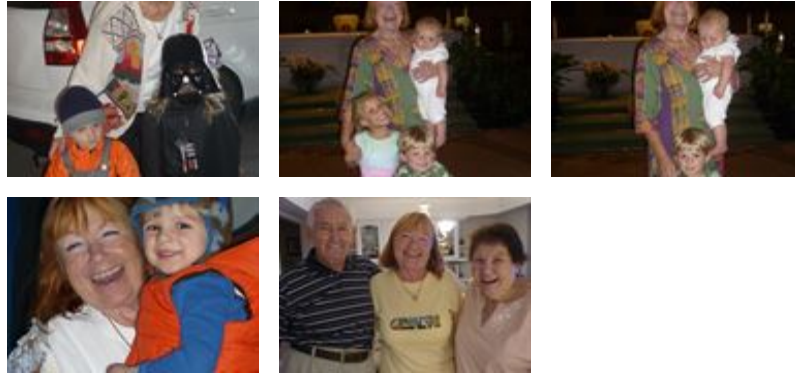
