Linda Carol Oprean was born on Friday, January 17, 1941. She was the eldest daughter of George Oprean and Margerat Mason-Oprean. She passed away peacefully into the loving arms of her Savior on Saturday, April 19, 2025.

Linda was born and raised in the Detroit area and never lived more than 30 miles from the place of her birth. She raised five children, all of whom survive her. She also has eight grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren and one great-great grandson.

She was married to Robert Fraley on July 10, 1960. Together they made a home in Rochester and raised their four sons and one daughter.

On November 10, 1985, she married Richard Rofkar. They remained happily together until his passing in December 2013.

Linda's life was defined by her deep and abiding faith in the Lord and her simple, almost child-like wonder at his creation. One of her favorite verses was, "We are fearfully and wonderfully made!" She loved babies and gardening and animals, especially her beloved poodle Mia, who preceded her in death this past Christmas.

Linda carried a song in her heart everywhere she went. She would often sing

her answers to questions posed to her. Many of those songs she learned in Sunday School or in old Hollywood musicals.

Her friends, many of whom have known her since grade school, remember her as a loving, creative, funny person who could be the “life of the party” while struggling to socialize in large groups. She was always at her best in small settings, playing games with the kids or making cookies while belting out “All I want for Christmas is You!” while everyone danced & laughed.

She will be remembered by those who knew her best as a little woman with the courage of a lioness, especially in defense of her children.

She will be missed dearly, but her legacy of love and faith will survive for generations.
