Lois Ann Woods (nee Woodrow), age 96, entered her eternal life early the morning of October 26, 2021. Lois passed surrounded by her daughter Pamela and son and daughter-in-law Jeffrey and Marsha. Lois had been in hospice care at her home, where she lived with her son Jeffrey and Marsha.
