



Lt. Col. Leonard E. Bogusz

August 8, 1919 - October 20, 2004

Lt. Colonel Leonard Edward Bogusz, USAF Retired, passed away on October 20, 2004 in Daytona Beach, Florida.

He was born August 8, 1919 in Hamtramck, Michigan to Theodore Bogusz and Rosa Opranski Bogusz, who immigrated in the early part of the twentieth century from Poland, each of them settling in the Detroit Area where they met and married. Lt. Col. Bogusz entered the U.S. Army in March of 1941 as a private. After completing Officer Candidate School he was commissioned an Army Medical Administrative Officer, serving in that capacity during World War II.

After leaving the Service in 1945, he returned to Detroit, but remained in Reserve Officer status being called back into active duty in August 1950 during the Korean Conflict and continued to serve in the U.S. Air Force retiring in 1975 from Strategic Air Command, Malmstrom Air Force Base, Great Falls, Montana.

Lt. Col. Bogusz lived the remainder of his life in South Daytona Beach, Florida where he enjoyed health and played golf at the Daytona Beach Country Club for the next twenty years. From 1990 to 2000 he was a volunteer delivering Meals on Wheels for the Council on Aging.

Survivors are his wife of 37 years, Edith Stegall Raubaugh Bogusz, children Vincent William Raubaugh of Daytona Beach and Edith A. Raubaugh Mosesso and grandson Mario J. Mosesso of Port Orange; sister Sophie Bogusz Godek and brother Arthur Bogusz of Warren, Michigan.
