But Rick came through and donated his kidney to you which you had all the way to the end of your life. When the doctors told you that you should never have children, I made sure that you and John were Godparents to my first born son Todd, and when I was pregnant with my second child I had made the decision that that child would carry a part of yours or Johns name which John was the lucky one when I gave birth to a boy Timothy John. You loved both of my sons as if they were your own. Then God blessed you and even though the doctors did not want you to go through that pregnancy, you wanted to be a mother and give that child all the love that you could give and you were blessed with a healthy son Richard for whom you loved with all your heart. And when you called me from the hospital on that day in December of 2012 and told me that you had to tell me something but you were afraid how I was going to take the news.... Chemo treatments, surgery, and more chemo treatments, I can honestly say that I would not have done anything any differently along the way. I feel so blessed that you came to stay with me for those 3 weeks, those 3 weeks that I spoiled you rotten, that I made every food you had a taste for even though you could only eat a little, all the times that I crawled in bed with you to watch T.V. the times we watched T.V. together in the living room, the couple times you came in the kitchen to help me cook.... And of course all our talks together....I would do nothing differently..... Then I really wanted to die, when you gave me the news that there was nothing

*they could do and you only had a few weeks, but together we cried, we talked, we held each other tightly, we were so honest with everything we talked about. My seester I hope that you are happy with everything I am doing for you.. And you asked me to promise you that I would watch over John and Richard and that I would not let them get into a dark hole.... I am keeping my promise and keeping in touch with them and trying to keep them on a good path, they know that there are many family and friends who love them and are here for them..... And on that note MY SEESTER, I hope you know how much I love you and my wish for you is that you rest in peace, the pain is gone and although I feel so empty right now, I will look forward to the time that we will be reunited again together as THE TWINS..... Until then my love.....*

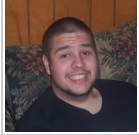

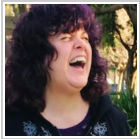

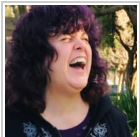
