She was known as a 'food snob' and a wanna be gourmet cook. Famous for her melt-in-your mouth pecan puffs, after 20 years in Louisville, admitted her biscuits were more like hockey pucks. She loved music and dancing. Blessed with a beautiful voice as a child sang the "standards" while her father played the piano. She was a genius with word games and puzzles, enjoyed Mah Jong, Text Twist and Hearts. She was a girly girl, loved lots of 'bling', proud of being

5 feet 12 inches tall, and appreciated the elegance of high heels. She was fiercely loyal and would do anything for her friends and family.

Marchell is survived by her mother Mary, her sister Kathleen (Dennis Janeczko) Hoste, her nieces Jenna Morton and Nicole (Scott) Breslin, her sister in law Mary Vassallo-Hoste and also by many loving aunts, uncles and cousins. She was predeceased by her father Norbert, her brother Lawrence, and her sister Barbara. She was much loved and will be greatly missed.
