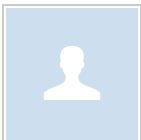

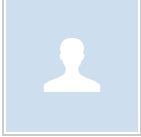

I well remember Maurice during my visit to all the family almost 20 years ago. He was a very nice man and loved all the members of the family.

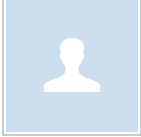

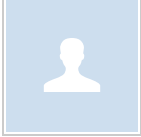
