(I'm sorry this is after the fact. I would have liked to express my words personally at the funeral home, but I had a couple of deaths in my family and couldn't make it).

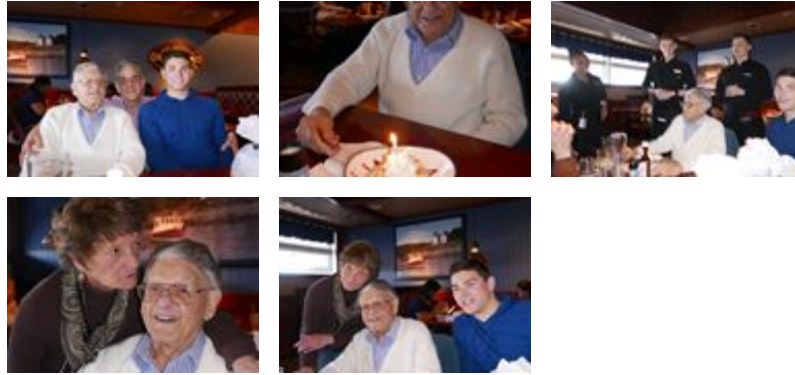
