After retiring, he continued serving others at Wasik Funeral Home.

A Korean War veteran, Norman served honorably in the 40th Infantry Division and received the Combat Medic Badge – Korea. He was a graduate of U of D Jesuit and Eastern Michigan University, and retired after 30 years with Lockheed Martin on the Lance Missile Project.

A devoted community member, he served on the Pleasant Ridge Recreation Board, St. Mary Credit Union Board, and as Athletic Director at St. Mary Elementary in Royal Oak. He coached CYO girls' basketball and directed invitational tournaments. His service earned him the Ed Crow Award for

outstanding contributions to youth in the CYO program.

Norman also gave his time to the Salvation Army, Capuchins, and St. Leo's Church.
