CLINTON TWP – Pamela “Pam” May Scramlin, 77, passed away July 2, 2025, peacefully at home and surrounded by her family.

Pam was born Nov. 10, 1947, in Detroit. She was raised in Redford, MI. Pam is survived by her beloved husband of 56 years, Phillip “Phil”; children, Rebecca (Jeffrey) Lundy and Jeffrey (Danielle) Scramlin; and cherished grandchildren, Kayla, Taylor, McKenna, Grant, and Carter. In 1983, Pam went back to school to pursue a degree in accounting and spent much of her career at T.I. Automotive until her retirement in 2006.

snorkeling, and especially traveling. Pam and Phil explored the U.S. in their Winnebago and traveled extensively internationally. After retirement, they began escaping Michigan winters by spending time in Nokomis, FL, where Pam enjoyed playing cards, golfing and spending time with friends at the pool and beach.
