June 7, 1949 - January 6, 2023

Paul Stieber of Algonac died on Friday, January 6, 2023, at St. John Hospital on Moross at age 73. He was born in Detroit to Aloysius and Aurelia Stieber on June 7, 1949.

Devoted husband of Jacqueline, to whom he was married for 50 years, Paul is also survived by his three sons: Paul (Olivia), Patrick (Jill), and Bradley as well as five grandchildren: Isabelle, PJ, Jack, Emma, and Kate. He was predeceased by his only sibling, Albert (Ann).

Paul attended St. Juliana Grade School and Servite High School, served in the U.S. Air Force Reserves, and for 36 years he was a Detroit firefighter at engine houses primarily on Detroit's east side including at Coplin and Jefferson, Hart and Jefferson, and Houston-Whittier and Gratiot. When not fighting fires, Paul worked as a driver for Stroh's Beer, Miller Beer, and Genso Trucking.

Over the course of his life Paul was a champion racquetball player, a wicked good cook, and a loving uncle. He coached all three of his sons, and countless other kids, as a coach in the Cannon Parent Baseball League in the 1980s; he took motorcycle trips to Sturgis; and he vacationed and boated and fished on the Great Lakes. In retirement Paul and Jacqueline moved to Algonac and enjoyed views of the St. Clair River and spent time with their

sons and grandchildren in Michigan and out in Oregon. They had many good times and adventures with countless friends.
