Peggy Parmentier of Chesterfield, MI was born on February 18, 1938, and passed away on November 13, 2022 at the age of 84 after a short illness.

She was a 1951 graduate of St. Lawrence Grade School and a 1955 graduate of Utica High School. In 1956, she started work as a bank teller at Mount Clemens Savings Bank. Over the years, there were many name changes and she retired from Huntington Bank in 1997 as a branch manager. After retirement, she worked part time at Premier Lanes Bowling Alley until 2018.

She loved to sew, knit, crochet, bowl, ski, camp and traveled whenever possible. She made the most beautiful and intricate quilts using her sewing and embroidery skills.

Her life was full of joy, being with her family and all her friends. In her words “I have the best family and friends in the whole world. I depend on all of you a lot, you are always there for me. Thank you everyone.”

She was predeceased by her parents, Marcel and Madeleine Parmentier, and her sister Barbara and brother-in-law Jack Matthies. She also had two brothers, Eugene and George, that passed away at a young age.

She is survived by her niece Tammy (Steven) Brown of Maryville, TN, nephew Kevin (Felicia) Matthies of Wichita, KS, and great nephew Kyle Matthies of Fort Worth, TX.

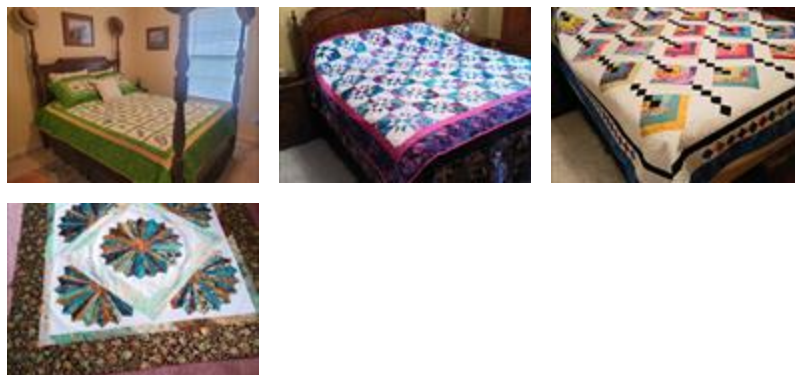
