



## Reverend Francis S. Skalski

November 21, 1928 - October 20, 2010

Rev. Francis S. Skalski Passed away October 20, 2010 at the age of 81. He was born November 21, 1928 in Detroit.

Fr. Skalski attended St. Mary's Orchard Lake and St. John's Provincial Seminary in Plymouth. He was ordained to the Priesthood June 2, 1956. Fr. Skalski was an Associate Pastor of St. Florian in Hamtramck (1956-1960), St. John Cantius in Detroit (1960-1965), St. Ladislaus in Hamtramck (1965-1969) and Our Lady Queen of Heaven in Detroit (1969-1971). He served as Pastor of St. Hyacinth in Detroit for over 35 years (1971-2007).

Beloved son of the late Steve and Frances Skalski. Dear brother of Stella (Jim) Przybylski, Richard Skalski and the late Roman (the late Frances) Skalski. Dear uncle of many loving nieces and nephews and grand nieces and nephews.
