



Rev. Richard A. Ugolik

January 25, 1928 - July 16, 2009

Rev. Richard A. Ugolik was born January 25, 1928, in New Britain, Connecticut. At the age of five, the family moved and settled in Detroit. Father attended St. Andrew's School in Detroit until the 8th grade. While attending high school at Orchard Lake, the family left Detroit and settled permanently in Grand Rapids.

Father Ugolik attended Orchard Lake High until graduation in 1946, then entered college there until 1950. Afterward, he continued his education at St. John's Seminary until 1954.

Father Ugolik was ordained into the priesthood for service in the Archdiocese of Detroit on Saturday, June 5, 1954, by his Eminence Edward Cardinal Mooney. The Ordination Ceremony was celebrated at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral in Detroit. The Mass of Thanksgiving was celebrated June 6, 1954, at Sacred Heart Church in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Father's first assignment was at St. Stanislaus Parish where he served for five years. His second assignment was at Our Lady Queen of Apostles for another five years. Father Ugolik's third assignment was at St. Christopher's Parish from June of 1964 to March of 1966. Father Ugolik then went to St. Bartholomew's Parish where he served as an assistant until August 20, 1972, when he became Pastor of St. Bartholomew's. Father Rich retired from his

active role as pastor of St. Bartholomew's in 1995 and moved to Washington Township where he became active with St. Kieran's Parish in Shelby Township. Father Ugolik is the beloved son of the late Alex and Lottie Ugolik. Dear brother of the late Robert. Greatly beloved cousin and best friend of Gail Carvlin. Dear nephew of Walter Rosegnal and daughter Joan.
