Robert A. Zuzga, age 84, of Macomb, MI, passed away on Wednesday, April 17th, 2024. He was born on Saturday, January 20th, 1940 in Detroit, Michigan.

Robert proudly served his country in the Air Force and later went on to have a successful career as an IT Manager. He was a dedicated employee and a respected member of his community.
