Roberta even earned herself a 'Hole in One' on one course. She was on several leagues and enjoyed spending time with her friends in the fresh air and sunshine on the beautiful greens.

Roberta's greatest joy in life were her two grandchildren – Jack and Mary. She moved closer to her daughter as soon as her first grandchild was born. She helped babysit, care for and love her grandchildren and often said – I should have been a grandmother first. Rain, or shine she showed up front and center for every baseball game/tournament, horse show, birthday party, graduation – she never missed an event. You'd often find her clapping and cheering the loudest from the stands.

Roberta loved being a Snowbird. She was able to enjoy the beauty of Michigan in the summers and fall and the winters in Florida. Roberta finished out her mission in life in the Sunshine State surrounded with love and warmth, but in true form went out fighting like the strong, stubborn sassy lady she was in life. 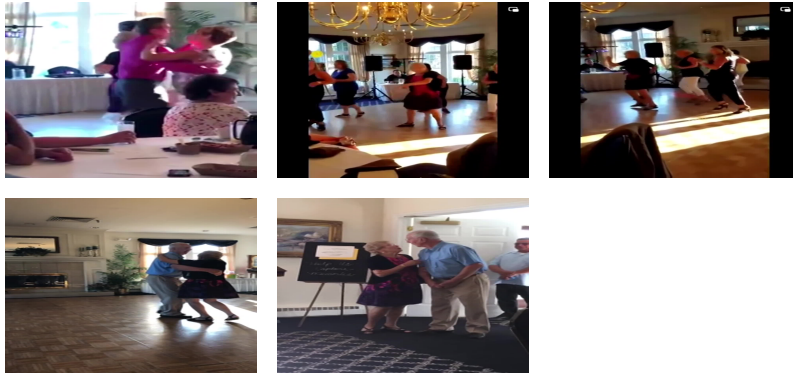
