Ronald Thomas Rice, of Chesterfield, Michigan, passed away on March 16, 2026, at the age of 83. He was born on February 15, 1943, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Russell and Anna Rice.

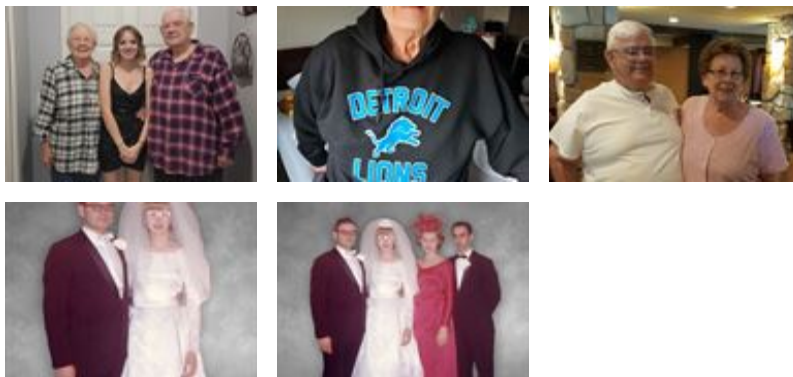
