She loved pets and lived with her dog Shiloh and had an African Grey parrot who she named Rocky which lives with her parents at their home in Michigan.

She will be remembered as someone who never gave up fighting for what she believed in, no matter what stood in her way.

Scherry is survived by her parents, Feroze and Rubina, and her two younger

brothers, Shayan and Shiraz.
