He was an Electricians Mate Master Chief in the US Navy for 9 years, serving WWII and another 20 years in the Naval Reserve. He served aboard the USS John A. Bole during the war. They were members of St. Raymond Parish for 43 years, where Stan was a lector and EME. A Volunteer with the Naval Sea Cadets and an active member of De La Salle Fathers Club.
