Thomas Edward Lamb, age 86 of Lincoln, Michigan, and formerly of Fair Haven, passed away on November 22, 2021.

Tom was born in Detroit to Thomas and Shirley Lamb (nee Lockart). He was raised by Ethel and Ed Binge, his aunt and uncle, after the deaths of his parents. He attended Wilbur Wright School, learning tool and die and drafting. He worked for Bordon Creamery and installed fences in the Grosse Pointe area. He worked for BTM Corporation drawing machines and tools. He was a carpenter who helped many friends and relatives build or remodel their homes and worked for Unified Church Structures building churches in the metro Detroit area. He retired from Algonac Schools after 17 years working as a custodian, mostly at the high school.

Tom served in the Army in the medical core in Germany.

Tom was a hunter and fisherman. He moved to Lincoln, Michigan, after his retirement with the intent to live the rest of his life in God's country. He watched the deer, turkey, and bears from his dining room window and built many bird houses and feeders for the wildlife.
