November 20, 1964 - July 14, 2024

Todd Gerard Hammond of Algonac passed away on July 13, 2024, at the age of 59. Todd was a beloved son, brother, husband and father. Born on November 20, 1964, in Detroit to Carol and Rowland Hammond, Todd was raised in Chesterfield where he loved living on the water. He graduated from Anchor Bay High School in 1982 and studied at both Northern Michigan University and Macomb Community College where he earned an associate's degree and became a pattern maker. He enjoyed a 40-year career at RCO Engineering where he created prototype parts for the automotive, aerospace and other industries. Todd met Stacey at RCO and they married in 2010 and went on to have a son, Mason.

Todd was an avid hunter enjoying goose, deer and bear hunting in northern Michigan. In his early years he often boasted that he shot his annual limit of ducks in both Canadian and American waters, earning him the nickname "Duckman". Todd also loved to fish, especially with his son.

Todd is survived by his wife of nearly 14 years, Stacey (nee Croke) Hammond; son Mason; mother Carol Hammond; sister Kit Hammond Scheessele (Greg Scheessele); in-laws David and Donna Croke; brother-in-law Steve Lesterson; brother-in-law Mike Croke (Margo); brother-in-law Jeff Croke; and brother-in-law Steve Croke (Rachel).
