



## William V. Glazer, II

October 31, 1930 - May 2, 2016

William "Bill" Vincent Glazer, II

Bill expired peacefully of natural causes on May 2, 2016 at his home in Shelby Township with his family present. Bill was 85 and had endured a series of TIA strokes.

He was born at home in Detroit, the son of William V. and Martha (nee Wagner), on October 31, 1930. Bill was the younger brother to one sister, Rosemary Glazer Mancani. He entered the service after graduating from East Detroit High School in 1948. Bill served the 3 years he enlisted for - and then one more for Harry, as they called it - in the Navy during the Korean Conflict. He married Dolores Haggerty of East Detroit 10 months after being discharged on July 11, 1953. They had 2 sons: Michael Karl Glazer now of Climax, MI. And his namesake, William Vincent Glazer III now of Fraser, MI. He retired from the Detroit Police Department with the rank of Lieutenant at age 48. Bill and Dolores remained married for 63 years until his death. He received his last wish which was to leave this world as he entered - at home with family.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents and sister.

Bill is survived by his wife Dolores Glazer, his sons William V. (Sharon) Glazer

III, and Michael (Cindy) Glazer. He was "Papa" to his grandchildren William V. Glazer IV, Eric (Lindsey) Glazer, Rachel (Chris) Nowak, Jenny (Marc) Chipault, Michael Glazer II and Steven (Kaylee) Glazer and also to his great-grandchildren Easton Nowak and Cora Glazer. Bill was also Grandpa to Ely Duckett, Julia Straw Limback (Matt), and Chris Straw.

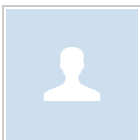

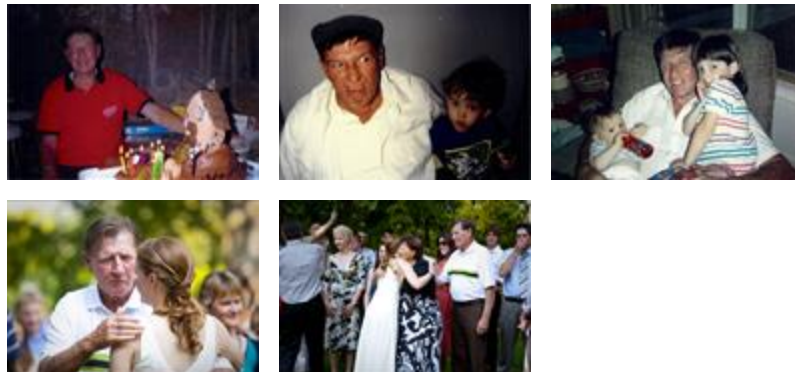
