William N. "Bill" Ringler was born on February 3, 1939, in Fraser, Michigan to Nicholas and Magdalena Ringler. Bill passed away at his home in Mt. Clemens, Michigan on December 6, 2022, at the age of 83.

Bill was a 1957 graduate of St. Mary's High School, where he was an All-County baseball and football player. Bill then went onto Western Michigan University, playing football and hockey for the Broncos. He graduated in 1961 with a bachelor's degree of Business Administration.
