Yewell O. Brown, age 79, passed away June 7, 2007 in Warren, Michigan. He was the second of five children born to Stella Stone and Prestoin Brown in Tennessee. Yewell moved to Michigan with his family when he was a young boy. In the early 1950's, a friend convinced Yewell to go to a coworker's wedding. There he met Katherine Nau. They married on April 19, 1952 and had three sons and six grandchildren. Yewell was very proud of his sons and he doted on his grandchildren. Yewell was in the Army and served during the Korean War. One week after marrying Katherine, he was sent to Camp Breckenridge, Kentucky before serving his duty in Austria.
